

Sample abstract for the *CMPT* 2006 conference in Kharkiv

These instructions describe how to prepare and submit an abstract using \LaTeX 2 ϵ for reviewing and publishing in “Books of Abstracts” of the *CMPT* 2006.

Your conference abstract must be prepared in \LaTeX 2 ϵ and submitted before 1 April 2006. Please, send the abstract as the body of your email to “cmpt06@ilt.kharkov.ua”. In the subject line give words “cmpt06 abstract”.

The entire abstract, from the top of the title text to the bottom of the last line, must not exceed 25 cm.

If you have no access to \LaTeX 2 ϵ , you may download the pdf version of this abstract from the *CMPT* 2006 webpage.

The abstract should strictly follow the instructions given in the template. Please, do not use other style files or exotic fonts. The abstract should contain up to one page of information. It should be informative and not only indicate the general scope of the presentation but also state the main results obtained and conclusions drawn. The abstract should be complete in itself.

You may use formulas and references in your abstract. The way of adding the bibliography should strictly follow the given example [1, 2, 3]. Please do not use other styles or commands. We intend to reproduce the abstracts at 70 percent of this size, which might be good to know if you have very fine indices or details in formulas.

Good luck with the abstract preparation, and welcome to Kharkiv in September 2006.
